Format Instructions

- Use 8.5 x 11-inch, single spaced with 1-inch margins at top, left, right, and bottom.
- The abstract cannot exceed one page.
- The text of the abstract must appear in Times New Roman 12-point font.
- Abstracts cannot include figures, tables, or charts.

Title: The title of your abstract must be in bold.

Authors: List each author last name first followed by their first initial. If more

> than one academic affiliation will be listed under "Affiliations" below, you must insert a number in superscript by each author's name to denote their individual academic institution affiliation.

Example:

Author(s): Dallasen R¹, Hirko A³, Xu Y^{1,2}

Affiliation(s): Enter the academic affiliation for each author so that is corresponds

to the superscript notations for each author as listed above.

Abstract: Use the following format to prepare the body of your abstract:

<u>Introduction</u> - Describe the context and importance of the study and

state the objective(s) of the study.

<u>Hypothesis</u> – State the hypothesis that was tested.

Methods – Include a description of the methods used considering study design, setting, population, measures, and analytic

procedures.

Results – Describe the results in sufficient detail to support the

conclusions.

<u>Conclusions</u> – Summarize and state your conclusions derived from

the study.

<u>Significance</u> – State the implications of the findings for science,

clinical practice, education, or policy.

Research / Grant Support – List all sources of support for the study.
