Who May Submit an Abstract

Postdoctoral fellows, interns/residents, pre-doctoral students, medical students and undergraduates from the following departments: Anesthesiology & Perioperative Medicine, Critical Care Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Neurological Surgery, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, and WISER. We will also consider abstract submissions by trainees at other institutions who are currently mentored by our former fellows, residents, or faculty.

Submission Requirements

Work not previously published is eligible. Work previously presented at a professional meeting in the current academic year is still eligible; however, the work cannot have been presented at a prior Safar Symposium.

Detailed submission guidelines—including the required abstract format and the abstract cover page—are available on the Safar Center website.

Carefully read and refer to the online guidelines for preparing and submitting your abstract. **Abstracts that do not adhere to the guidelines will be rejected.**

Deadline

Abstracts must be emailed with the abstract cover page to SafarTRD@pitt.edu by **5 pm, Thursday April 15, 2021.**

Notification

The communicating author will be notified of their abstract's status during the week of April 26. Session details will follow for abstracts accepted for presentation.

On The Virtual Day

First authors will present their abstract as 4 slides (1 title, 3 content) for 5-6 mins plus Q&A for 4-5 mins (10 mins total). Presentations will be judged by two faculty experts who will serve as the session moderators.

Category Winners

Authors with the strongest abstract in each research category will receive a prize.
